**Informal discussion:** Refreshments will be provided. parking (match days, grass verges, overall shortage of spaces)
poverty (Leeds Debt Forum, Community Hub, self-help groups)

traffic problems (St Ann's Lane, Queenswood Drive, Kirkstall Lane, Morris Lane, Bridge Road

gyratory system, any additional problem areas?)
